

Terms of participation I (Historic Motorsport):

- Access times to drivers paddock: Friday from 9 am to 9 pm Saturday from 7 am to 8 am
- ⇒ Vehicle inspection: Friday from 1pm at the prestart, Saturday from 8 am
- ⇒You will receive your start number at the prestart during the vehicle inspection.
- ⇒ Drivers briefing on Friday, 3pm and Saturday at 8:15am at prestart.
- ⇒ Please follow the instructions of the Technorama-Staff. Night's rest has to be kept.
- **≡** Each participant must have 1 fire extinguisher in the drivers paddock!
- **⇔ Bikes:** Helmet duty, motorcycle gloves, solid shoes
- **⇔** Wearing racing suits is mandatory!
- **⇔Vehicles:** Helmet duty, seat belt duty, racing suit, body-covering and flame retardant clothing
- **➡** The helmets and the fire extinguisher are to be presented at the entrance.
- All vehicles have a noise limit of 98 dB (A) at 5000 rpm.
- ⇔On the Technorama area, such as the drivers paddock speed is limited to 5 km/h. The German StVO regulation apply.
- ⇒ Open fire and easily flammable material is not allowed on the Technorama area.
- After disassembly please leave your stand tidy. Otherwise cleaning and removal of rubble and bulky waste will be charged to your account.
- ⇒ In case of non-compliance to the terms of participation, we reserve the right to charge you a contractual penalty up 3.000 Euro.
- ⇒ The organizer is liable only in case of intention or serious negligence, according to the German Federal Regulations § 823 BGB
- ⇒With registration and total payment of fees, the terms of participation, Allgem. Messe- und Ausstellungsbedingungen and the privacy information are accepted by the participant.

Terms of participation II ((Historic Motorsport):

1. Participants, vehicles:

Automobiles and motorcycles up to YOC 1989 are eligible to participate. The confirmation of the registration as well as the selection of the vehicles is carried out by the organizer according to automotive-historical criteria with the greatest possible brand and type variety as well as after the date of receipt of the registration. The decision of the organizer can not be challenged. NEW: In accordance with the general guidelines of the DMSB, a noise level limit of 98 dB (A) applies to all vehicles.
