Technorama - for the 40th time in Ulm!

No way was the vintage fans too far to pursue their passion on the first weekend of May at the Technorama Ulm. The visitors and exhibitors communicated in different languages, also with interpreters and hand signals, and the meetings showed the European solidarity of the classic car scene. The approximately 850 exhibitors and 25.000 visitors enjoyed the relaxed atmosphere of the Technorama, the warm sunshine and rummaged through the offer in the halls and in the outdoor area.

The screwdrivers and collectors bought fenders, hoods, tires and care products, to name only a small part of the goods. Numerous vehicles of the classic cars for sale changed their owners. A Citroen 11CV was already sold early on Saturday. It was followed by a Citroen 2CV, an Austin Healey Sprite, several SLK, a Moto Guzzi and a Lamborghini tractor, just to name a few. Gorgeous vehicles were also to be found at the traditional classic car meeting. The classic car clubs presented their activities and offered the opportunity to exchange experiences. In particular, the Z-friends Ulm / Neu-Ulm e.V. and the VFF-Ulm (veteran vehicle friends Ulm / Neu-Ulm e.V.) had issued a whole series of beautiful vehicles. The VFF-Ulm presented a Rover 14 HP "ODIN", which was restored for 5 years and equipped as a "special" with a new body in a historic way.

The series of exhibited tugs in Hall 7 showed a colorful variety. Among the bulldogs from the legendary Mannheim tractor manufacturer Heinrich Lanz, Hanomag or the Polish tractor manufacturer Ursus also Italian Lamborghini tractors joined in orange-blue or patina.
