In the classic car scene, as one of the largest and best-stocked parts markets, Technorama Ulm left almost nothing to be desired.

In 10 halls and on 20.000 m<sup>2</sup> of outdoor space, the search for spare parts, chrome strips, spark plugs and accessories as well as literature and miniature models became an experience. The many specialists among the parts dealers not only had good products but also passed on valuable information and were able to answer many questions. They specialize in both brands, e.g. BMW, Ferrari or on products such as carburetors, rims, tanks or speedometers.

The clubs, associations and IGs were also revealing, presenting numerous and beautiful vehicles and inviting classic car fans to talk to like-minded people. They gave tips for restoration and repair work or travel. You could buy the classics at the vehicle sale in the Donauhalle. As always, the variety of vehicles on display was impressive and the prices reasonable.

The lovers of historical agricultural technology used the traditional meeting place for a traditional breakfast among like-minded people. In addition to the usual range, there were also tractor parts from a barn liquidation. The big tractors and Unimogs always attract visitors.
