Technorama Hildesheim – The experience!

On 24 and 25 May 2025, Hildesheim airfield will be transformed into an Eldorado for classic car and vintage enthusiasts with petrol in their blood. At Technorama Hildesheim, lovers of historic vehicles can not only purchase parts and accessories but also admire the well-kept vehicles at the classic car meeting. At the historic motorsport event, cars and motorbikes and their drivers thrill visitors live on the circuit.

The classic car market has plenty of spare parts, old technology, restoration materials and classic car accessories for mechanics, collectors and hobbyists. Some restored vintage and classic cars are for sale, as well as several Harley machines. The classic car scene in the north is represented by attractive club stands, e.g. MVC, Deuvel and Oldtimerfreunde Hildesheim. The club members provide information on everything you want to know about technology etc., give tips and are happy to welcome new members. A very special rarity will be on the MVC stand, a Mercedes-Benz L319 van with original refrigerators from Liebherr.

The classic car meeting at Lerchenkamp airfield is like a visit to a museum for visitors. Each of the many classic cars and motorbikes has its own charm. At the classic car meeting, vehicles built up to 1980 may park on the grounds free of charge and the driver has free entry. For vehicles built between 1981 and 1994, parking is free, but the driver pays an entrance fee.

The starters are in their element at **the classic car comparison races of historic motorsport**. More than 250 racing drivers show off their driving skills in 11 classes on the 2.7 km track. There are several motorbike classes, a sidecar class, one class each for formula and pre-war vehicles, Porsche, aero and other automobile classes. The variety and appearance of the vehicles and the passion of the drivers are inspiring. These comparative races offer spectators an exciting programme, as does the paddock, which is open to visitors, where they can view the historic motorsport vehicles and talk to the drivers. There will also be a presentation to mark the 70th anniversary of the NSU Sportmax world champion in the motorbike class up to 250 cc.

Opening hours are Saturday from 9 am to 6 pm and Sunday from 9 am to 4 pm. The day ticket costs 15 euros, children up to the age of 12 are free. The visitor car park is located
