Technorama Hildesheim – The classic car event of the north!

On 25 and 26 May 2024, classic car and youngtimer enthusiasts with petrol in their blood came to Technorama. In Hildesheim, lovers of historic vehicles can not only purchase parts and accessories, but also experience the cars and motorbikes live in action at the historic motorsport event. The smell of petrol, the sound of engines and beautiful vehicle models thrilled the spectators.

The well-stocked classic car market had plenty of spare parts, old technology, restoration materials and classic car accessories for mechanics, collectors and hobbyists. Some lovingly restored classic and vintage cars were also on sale. The classic car scene in the north was represented by attractive club stands, e.g. MVC, Deuvet and Oldtimerfreunde Hildesheim. The members provided information, gave tips on all aspects of historic cultural assets in discussions with like-minded people and looked for new members.

The classic car meeting directly on the Lerchenkamp airfield captivated visitors with its many classic vehicles. From the Fiat 500 to the Big Bumper, from the 2CV to the Ferrari, every vehicle had its charm. At the classic car meeting, vehicles built up to 80 parked on the site free of charge and the driver had free entry. For vehicles built between 81 and 94, only parking was free.

The classic car comparative races of historic motorsport on the 2.7 km long circuit were enthusiastically attended by the starters. More than 250 racers in 11 classes show off their driving skills. These included several motorbike classes, a sidecar class, one class each for formula and pre-war vehicles, Porsche, aero and other automobile classes. The variety and appearance of the vehicles and the passion of the drivers were amazing. These comparative races offered spectators a varied programme, as did the paddock, which was open to visitors and where they could view the vehicles - Renault Alpine, Karmann Ghia etc., various motorbikes and sidecars.
