Technorama Ulm: 3. + 4. Mai 2025

Traditioneller Oldtimermarkt – We meet in Ulm!

For the 45th time, mechanics, collectors and classic car enthusiasts from Europe met in Ulm at the Technorama, which extends over 40,000 square metres of indoor and outdoor exhibition space.

Well equipped with rucksacks or ladder wagons, the enthusiasts stood in front of the gates and waited eagerly for admission. A diverse selection of vehicles was on display in the Donauhalle. Visitors could admire Formula 3 and Formula Vau racing cars, an Audi B4 with only 250 kilometres on the clock, pre-war vehicles such as the sleek 1934 Wolseley, Porsche models in need of repair, numerous motorbikes, including a Honda 450K racing machine from 1971, and a nippy VW Golf III GTI, to name just a few highlights.

The classic car clubs, associations and IGs were meeting places for like-minded people. The VFF Ulm/Neu-Ulm presented 22 vehicles with history. In addition to the many conversations about the 'rustiest hobby in the world', all eyes were on the diverse exhibits. The Alt-Opel IG showed the Manta B from its most beautiful side, the VFV presented fire engines, among other things, and the Z-Stammtisch invited visitors to talk petrol. The other clubs also offered visitors interesting information and beautiful exhibits.

Around 800 exhibitors offered spare parts, accessories, miniature models, literature and everything the classic car heart desires. Rarities such as a 3-sound fan ride, a petrol tap expert and dealers with high-quality sheet metal parts attracted attention. Bicycles, mopeds, Vespas and restored machines from NSU, Harley, Triumph etc. also attracted attention. Ulm is also known for its BMW motorbike experts.

There was plenty to see for fans of historic agricultural machinery in Hall 7: experienced parts exhibitors, an inviting club stand from the Unimog-Club Gaggenau e.V. as well as Hanomag, Lanz and Schlüter tractors lined up in a row, for example.

The classic car meeting behind Hall 7 was also an attractive attraction for visitors, which also delighted and amazed them.
