30 – 31 May 2026 – Spare parts market + classic car meeting + hist. Motorsport – The hotspot for vehicles fans

On May 30 and 31, 2026, Technorama Hildesheim will serve as a hotspot for car and motorcycle enthusiasts. With a spare parts market, a classic vehicle meeting and a historic motorsport, there is something to suit every taste. Knowledgeable exhibitors, dedicated club stands, and vehicle vendors offer a wealth of information, personal advice and their products. The classic car meeting serves as a vibrant gathering place for enthusiasts to connect and converse with like-minded people. In the historic motorsport segment, around 250 drivers will take the start on the 2.7 km circuit. Spectators can follow the action from the grandstands or visit the competitors in the paddock.

At Technorama Hildesheim on May 30 and 31, 2026, visitors will encounter a **parts market** where vendors from across Germany offer thousands of spare parts, accessories, literature, and memorabilia for classic cars and motorcycles. Whether in search of engines, body panels, or interior trim, mechanics, restorers, and enthusiasts alike will find the right part here—and this year, a specialist in Saab and Volvo vehicles will also be in attendance. The northern classic car scene is well represented through attractive club displays, featuring groups such as the MVC, the Alt-Opel IG, and the Treser Club. Club members are on hand to provide information on all technical matters and related topics, offer expert tips, and enjoy engaging in conversation with fellow enthusiasts.

The **classic car meeting** held directly at the Lerchenkamp airfield resembles an open-air museum and shows the evolution of vehicles. The cars and motorcycles—representing a wide variety of brands and models—attract appreciative attention from visitors and serve as ideal subjects for photography. Vehicles manufactured up to 1980 are permitted to park on the grounds free of charge, and the driver receives free admission. For vehicles manufactured between 1981 and 1994, parking is free, but the driver must pay the admission fee.

In thrilling **vintage comparison runs** of historic motorsport, a diverse array of competitors takes to the track. On the 2.7 km circuit, more than 250 racers across 11 competitive classes showcase their driving prowess while bringing automotive history to life. Class 3 alone features a total of three former Grand Prix drivers on the starting grid—including Willem Heijkoop—as well as the competitors traveling the furthest to attend, hailing from Serbia and Finland! The event features a wide range of categories, including several motorcycle classes, a sidecar class, dedicated classes for Formula and pre-war vehicles, Porsche, Aero, and various other automotive classes—such as "Legends Are Back on Track." These comparison runs offer

spectators a thrilling spectacle, as does the paddock area, which is open to visitors, where the historic racing machines are on display.

Opening hours are Saturday from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. A day ticket costs 15 euros; admission is free for children up to 12 years of age. Leashed dogs are permitted. Visitor parking is located directly on the airfield grounds.
